

New transitional housing units to be built

The Homelessness Partnering Strategy (HPS) will provide \$917,640 to the North End Women's Centre to construct a transitional housing facility on Selkirk Avenue. This new building will contain six transitional housing units, kitchen and laundry facilities, a children's play area, office space and a supportive programming area for community women, who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, and are struggling with addictions, safety and chronic transience.
