

People living in Warman's sheds again

A man is still living in a utility shed behind a Winnipeg home despite a crackdown by city officials last fall.

Charlie Warman, who rented the furnished and insulated sheds for \$100 a month, was fined \$247 in September when inspectors visited his Horace Street home and said the practice was a violation of the city's health and safety codes.
