

# Councillor wants landlords ticketed for lack of heat

Coun. Harvey Smith introduced a motion to Winnipeg city council Wednesday morning that would introduce a ticket system for landlords who did not keep their tenants' suites at 21 C or higher.

You really want adequate heat, and we have a livability bylaw with the set amount of heat that you must have," said Smith. "If they're not complying, they should in effect get a ticket just like you get a ticket if you've been caught speeding."

The Livability Bylaw currently requires that buildings must be heated to a minimum of 18C during the evenings and 21C during the day.
