

University of Winnipeg unveils plan for \$27M residence

Downtown Winnipeg is getting a new, \$27-million apartment building with units ranging from premium to low-income suites.

The 14-storey, 102-suite complex — a partnership between the University of Winnipeg and government of Manitoba — is set to go up near the corner of Portage Avenue and Memorial Boulevard.

Forty-six apartments will have affordable rents for lower-income people, with 32 of those being offered on a "rent-geared-to-income basis," according to the U of W.
